

- Preparatory reading / work for the coming semester
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

- = the basic teaching/exam unit
- can consist of one or several classes; there can be one single module exam, or separate exams for each module part (see PStO, "Anlage 2")





- We usually offer a range of specific classes for one module

- The same class can also be offered for several modules (and study programmes); the assignment/exam and number of ECTS you can get can differ depending on the module (and/or study programme) for which a student takes this class
- → it is important to know the module for which one is taking a class (see personal timetable in LSF)!





- Types of modules
 - P = obligatory modules ("Pflichtmodule")
 - → have to be taken by all students in the MA programme
 - WP = elective modules ("Wahlpflichtmodule")
 - → there is a choice between alternatives
 - → there are different selection options/rules for different groups of WP modules





Special case:

GGSP ("Gemeinsamer Geistes- und Sozialwissenschaftlicher Profilbereich")

- Choice among a broad selection of classes from subjects different than English Studies (30 ECTS)
- Decision either for GGSP or for 30 ECTS from PM packages 4-9 (no mixture/switching possible!)
- First semesters: GGSP PStO 2020





How do I enroll for classes?

- = "Belegen"
 - Where? In LSF
 - When? During the registration period (2 different registration periods for different types of classes)
 - → Current registration period for the winter term 2020/21:

12.10.-26.10.2020





How do I learn in which classes I have been accepted?

- The system runs an automatic distibution procedure, which can take a couple of days
- Then you can see which classes you got accepted for (= classes marked by ZUGELASSEN) in your timetable






What can I do in case I did not get a place in a class (or forgot to register)?

- Please contact the university teachers of this class directly and ask whether you can still get accepted
- There is, however, no guarantee for a place in a certain class

What you can look forward to








- lectures ("Vorlesung"/VL)

Exam registration ("Prüfungsanmeldung")

- Is not the same as enrollment for classes ("Belegen")!
- If you want to get the ECTS for a class you have to register for the exam
- If you do not register for the exam, than you cannot take the exam/get the credits (i.e. it is as if you never took the class)





How do I register for exams?

- Where? In LSF
- When? During exam registration period ("Prüfungsanmeldezeitraum")

Exam registration period in winter term 2020/21: Januar 18 - Januar 29, 2021

There is a different registration procedure and different deadlines for the MA thesis





What are the consequences of exam registration?

- Exam registration is binding
- i.e. if you have registered and do not write the exam/hand in the coursework (in time), than this means you have failed the class/module






Can I un-register from exams?

 Yes, it is possible to un-register in LSF up to 3 working days before the exam date











When do exams take place? What are the deadlines and requirements for passing a class?

- You will get all necessary information from the teachers of your classes
- Exam dates/submission deadlines are additionally indicated in LSF once you have registered for an exam
- All details on exams can be read in "Anlage 2" of the PStO

In winter term 2020/21 (almost) all exams will take place online and/or have the form of written work to be prepared at home and handed in in digital format. Accordingly, the exact type of exam may differ from what can be read in the PStO.





What happens if I fail an exam?

- You usually have a second try (and sometimes even a third one; see Anlage 2 of the PStO)
- It is **not** possible to repeat an exam without reattending the class/a class for the same module; i.e. **failed exams can only be repeated one term later**
- Exams which have been passed cannot be repeated for improving the grade





- A longer stay in an English-speaking country is obligatory
 - At least 2 month as part of the Intercultural Project (ICP)
 - or 6 months (self-organized, study abroad, etc.)
